Poster Contest Theme and Rules

In order to commemorate the District’s 100th Anniversary, this poster contest is meant to encourage JWD families to learn about the water cycle as it relates to groundwater. This includes their role in conserving water and protecting our water resources now and for future generations as well as the history of Jericho Water District. The poster can include any or all these topics.

All families within the Jericho Water District are eligible and encouraged to enter the contest. Categories include: K-2nd Grade, 3rd-5th grade, 6th – 8th grade, and 9th – 12th Grade. One winner will be chosen from each category. One entry per person. Deadline for receipt of poster is Monday, April 3rd, 2023.

Poster Requirements

Posters must clearly convey the theme. Students may use any type of drawing medium including paint, colored pencils, crayons, markers etc. The poster must be 8 ½” x 11”, landscape layout on a white background. Posters must contain original hand-drawn artwork. (No computer-generated posters or graphics. Copyrighted characters and clip art **will not be accepted**.) Posters should be easy to see and read.

- Creativity, originality, and artistic quality
- Visual Clarity

- Winning Posters will be showcased on Jericho Water District website and included in our Centennial Newsletter in May.

The 4 winning students will be acknowledged by the JWD Commissioners during our 100th Anniversary Ceremony.
