

Miss Cannon then requested authorization to transfer \$400,000.00 from the General Fund Checking Account to the Investment Account in order to maximize interest. After discussion, the Commissioners authorized the bank transfer.

Miss Cannon informed the Commissioners that she received a settlement offer for Claim No. 050025263 0101 014 from Geico Indemnity Company for fire hydrant damage that occurred on July 21, 2019 in the amount of \$1,743.26 (originally invoiced for \$2,100.53). Miss Cannon forwarded the settlement offer to Mr. Ingham who reviewed and recommended the District sign the release.

Miss Cannon then requested authorization from the Commissioners to appoint employee Jonathan Bassetta to the position of Water Servicer Trainee (previously holding position of Water Plant Attendant) effective October 25, 2022 with no change in salary. After discussion, the Commissioners authorized the appointment pending civil service approval.
